In order to implement the Robert Wood Johnson/Institute of Medicine Report, ***“The Future of Nursing: Leading Change, Advancing Health”***, the Campaign has been working to change the legislation governing the individual state nursing boards with the goal of having national uniform standards making the certification body the authority for scope of practice in the specialty and allowing APRNs to practice as solo providers within that specialty.
