



## **INTRODUCTION: CPT CODES & ICD-9 CODES**

*Current Procedural Terminology (CPT)* is a listing of descriptive terms and identifying codes for reporting medical services and procedures performed by physicians. The CPT codes are useful for administrative management purposes including claims processing.

*The International Classification of Diseases, 9<sup>th</sup> Revision (ICD-9)* is designed for the classification of morbidity and mortality information for statistical purposes, and for the indexing of hospital records by disease and operations, for data storage and retrieval.

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## **FAMILY PLANNING CPT CODES: Applicable to Male Services**

Office or other outpatient services

- New Patient
  - 99201:
    - A problem focused history / examination
    - Straightforward medical decision making
  - 99202:
    - An expanded problem focused history / examination
    - Straightforward medical decision making
  - 99203:
    - A detailed history / examination
    - Medical decision making of low complexity
  - 99204:
    - A comprehensive history / examination
    - Medical decision making of moderate complexity
  - 99205:
    - A comprehensive history / examination
    - Medical decision making of high complexity
- Established Patient
  - 99211:
    - May not require physician presence
    - Minimal problems; service time ~5 minutes
  - 99212:
    - A problem focused history / examination
    - Straightforward medical decision making
  - 99213:
    - An expanded problem focused history / examination
    - Medical decision making of low complexity
  - 99214:
    - A detailed history / examination
    - Medical decision making of moderate complexity
  - 99215:
    - A comprehensive history / examination
    - Medical decision making of high complexity



## **FAMILY PLANNING CPT CODES (Cont'd)**

### **Preventive Medicine Services (New / Established Patient)**

- 99384 / 99394: 12 – 17 yrs
- 99385 / 99395: 18 – 39 yrs
- 99386 / 99396: 40 – 64 yrs
- 99387 / 99397: 65+ yrs

### **Destruction of Lesions - Male Genital System**

- 54050: destruction of lesion(s) on penis (eg, condyloma, papilloma, molluscum contagiosum, herpetic vesicle), simple; chemical
- 54055: electrodesiccation
- 54056: cryosurgery
- 54057: laser surgery
- 54060: surgical excision
- 54065: destruction of lesion(s), penis, extensive (eg, laser surgery, electrosurgery, cryosurgery, chemosurgery)

### **Destruction of Lesions - Rectum**

- 46900: destruction of lesion(s) on anus, simple; chemical
- 46910: electrodesiccation
- 46916: cryosurgery
- 46917: laser surgery
- 46922: surgical excision
- 46924: destruction of lesion(s), anus, extensive

### **Destruction of Benign or Premalignant Lesions**

- 17110: destruction (eg, laser surgery, electrosurgery, cryosurgery, chemosurgery, surgical curettement), of benign lesions other than skin tags or cutaneous vascular proliferative lesions; up to 14 lesions
- 17111: 15 or more lesions

- Routine General Med Exam: V70.0
- Urethral discharge: 788.7
- Urethritis: 597.80
- Male genital disorder: 608.89
- Rash-dermatitis, eczema: 692.9
- Rash. non-specific skin eruption: 782.1
- Worried well: V65.5

## **Sample Male Family Planning Coding Scenarios Worksheet**

### **1. STI Screening Example**

Evaluation and Management Code Selection

Based on New (99201-99205) vs. Established (99211-99215)

S- CC: New Partner Clearance; HPI: 4 partner past 6 months; ROS: No discharge/dysuria

O- NAD, A&O X3; Temp: 98.6

A&P- Screening STI (V74.5); Safe sex and STI prevention discussed (V25.09)

HCPCS (CPT) Code: 99202 or 99213; ICD-9 Code as above

### **2. STI Infection Example**

Evaluation and Management Code Selection

Based on New (99201-99205) vs. (99211-99215)

S- CC: Discharge; HPI: White, penile d/c for one week; Worse in AM; ROS: + Dysuria, - lymph.; Social History: New partner within last month with unprotected intercourse

O- Somewhat distressed, A&O X3; Temp: 99.9; White, milky discharge from penis, no lesions or rash

A&P- Discharge (788.7), Dysuria, (788.1), Exposure to STI, (V01.6); Safe sex and STI prevention discussed (V25.09)

HCPCS (CPT) Code: 99203 or 99214 with 788.1 and V25.09; 36415 (Blood draw for RPR) with 788.7 and V01.6

### **3. Annual**

Evaluation and Management Code Selection

Based on New (99384-99387) vs. (99394-99397)

S- CC: Annual/CPE/Preventive; HPI: None necessary; 10+ ROS; PFSH: All 3

O- 8 or more Organ Systems (No Body Areas)

A&P- Normal Adult Preventive (V70.0); Safe sex and STI prevention discussed (V25.09)

HCPCS (CPT) Code: Based on age as above with V70.0



#### **4. Wart Evaluation with Aldara Treatment Example**

Evaluation and Management Code Selection

Based on New (99201-99205) vs. (99211-99215)

S- CC: Bumps; HPI: Clusters of white, raised bumps on penis and groin area starting 4 weeks ago; ROS: Neg dysuria/fever; Social History: Two partners, last 60 days

O- Somewhat distressed, A&O X3; Temp: 98.6; Raised veruca cell lesions, .25 cm in diameter with 3-4 in cluster on penile shaft and above base on groin area

A&P- Condyloma (078.11) with Aldara prescription; RTC two weeks; Safe sex and STI prevention discussed (V25.09)

HCPCS (CPT) Code: 99203 or 99214 with ICD-9 as above

#### **5. Wart Evaluation and Destruction Example**

Evaluation and Management Code Selection

Based on New (99201-99205) vs. (99211-99215)

S- CC: Bumps; HPI: Clusters of white, raised bumps on penis and groin area starting 4 weeks ago; ROS: Neg dysuria/fever; Social History: Two partners, last 60 days

O- Somewhat distressed, A&O X3; Temp: 98.6; Raised veruca cell lesions, .25 cm in diameter with 3-4 in cluster on penile shaft and above base on groin area

A&P- Condyloma (078.11) treated with TCA; RTC 7 days for retreatment; Safe sex and STI prevention discussed (V25.09)

HCPCS (CPT) Code: 99203 or 99214 (-25 modifier) with both ICD-9 as above and 17110 and 54050, both with ICD-9 of 078.11

#### **6. Wart Destruction Only (Destruction Coding Options)**

Code surgical service only UNLESS a “significantly, separately identifiable” problem raised at time of wart destruction which would result in also coding E&M

Wart Destruction (Cryo, Chemo, Laser, Electro.)

- Penile: 54050-54060 (Simple, method specific) & 54065 (Extensive)
- Anal: 46900-46922 (Simple, method specific) & 46924 All Benign Lesions- any other location: 17110 (up to 14) & 17111 (15+)
  - DO NOT USE 17000 & 17003
